



Announcement of NEA Teaching Fellow Opportunity

The National Education Association (NEA), the nation's largest educator organization with more than 3.2 million members, seeks a National Board Certified Teacher (NBCT) for a one-year Teaching Fellow position in NEA's Teacher Quality Department.

The full-time Teaching Fellow position is designed for a practicing National Board Certified Teacher who seeks opportunities to participate in NEA's policy and program development in the teacher quality arena, including:

- Supporting NEA projects that identify and promote effective strategies for recruiting, developing, and retaining quality teachers in high-needs schools
- Supporting NEA work to increase the number of minority candidates completing the National Board Certification process
- Supporting NEA's efforts to maintain and expand incentives/supports for teachers to pursue National Board Certification.

The Teaching Fellow position is housed in the Washington, D.C. headquarters of the NEA; and the assignment period is between September 7, 2009 and August 27, 2010. Some travel will be required as part of the assignment. The Teaching Fellow will retain his/her current teaching salary and benefit package during the one-year Fellowship.
